

6th Commonwealth Youth Games, Bahamas
India won one gold and three bronze medals in Judo

July 19, 2017: The introduction of Judo in the Youth Commonwealth games saw, Judokas from Australia, Scotland, India and Zambia also finished on top of the podium. Indian youth grabbed the limelight with clinching 3 bronze medals and 1 gold medal.

Soni from India won a Gold medal after defeating Nikolic by 01-00 in the 73 Kgs weight category. Following him was a bronze medal won by Ashish after defeating Zain of England by 10-00 in the 60 Kgs weight category.

In the girls' category, the Indian girls stood out clinching on two bronze medals at the event. Ms. Antim Yadav won bronze after defeating Russell Jasmine by 2-0 in the 48 Kgs weight category. Ms. Chanam Rebina Devi was another name that grabbed the bronze medal in the 57 Kgs weight category after defeating Saskia.

In the debut of Judo as a sport in Youth Commonwealth Games, Bahamas, India clinched a total of 4 medals, making the country proud.
